



CURRICULUM DELIVERY POLICY

Delivery of the curriculum shall foster student progress and achievement and meet all Board expectations and legislative requirements. Therefore the principal must ensure:

1. achievement of the Charter aims and targets;
2. compliance with the National Administration Guidelines;
3. there is a focus on the national priority groups of Maori, Pasifika and students with special learning needs in school planning and reporting;
4. that board approval is sought before changes to the school curriculum requiring increased expenditure or significant changes to programmes or staffing are made;
5. special character is embedded throughout the curriculum.

Review schedule: Triennially

GUIDELINES:

- This policy will enable the Board to provide programmes that will reflect the NZ Curriculum and to carry out its responsibilities in accordance with all of the Ministry of Education's guidelines.
- **The Principal will be responsible for implementing the school's curriculum and student achievement directions, in conjunction with the school's staff.**
- **The procedures as listed below relating to Curriculum and Student Achievement will be the responsibility of the Principal.**
- ***Responsibility for reviewing procedures will take place by the principal and school leaders on an "as of need" basis and all changes reported, confirmed and dated by the Board.***
